1960年代から70年代にかけて、先鋭的な写真と言葉で「政治の季節」を牽引した中平卓馬は、77年に急性アルコール中毒で倒れた。記憶の大部分と言葉の回転を失うこととなったが、それ以降、写真を撮ることが生活のほとんどすべてとなった。本作では中平に3年間密着、横浜の自宅周辺を日々撮影する姿や失われた記憶をなぞるようにかつて訪れた沖縄を再訪する姿を追った。

In the 1960s and 70s, NAKAHIRA Takuma led the 'Season of Politics' with his cutting-edge photography and textual work. However, he fell ill in 1977 due to acute alcoholism. This resulted in the loss of most of his memory as well as the flow of his words. Since then, photography has occupied most of his life. This piece is a documentary based on 3 years of observation, following how he photographed the area around his home in Yokohama on a daily basis, and his journey back to Okinawa, as if he were tracing backwards in his memory.
